Stroll the shops on Main Street and stop at **Wockenfuss** for a **chocolate covered pretzel**.

Head to Havre de Grace, stopping at **McShane’s Gourmet**, for a **chocolate scone and toffee coffee**. Enjoy a delicious seafood lunch at the **Bayou in Havre de Grace** and try their **delicious homemade chocolate pie**.

In Havre de Grace, visit the Decoy Museum and Maritime Museum, walk on the promenade to bank some calories to splurge on **Bomboy’s Homemade Candy (don’t miss the chocolate caramel cashew crabs)**. Shop the antique stores and art galleries in Havre de Grace. Stop into **Java by the Bay** for a **Milky Way espresso**. For those spending the night, enjoy a **chocolate themed dinner cruise aboard the Lantern Queen**, a replica of a Mississippi Steamboat.
