

Harford County Home Grown ***A Student Ag Tour***

Straddling the border of Maryland and Pennsylvania, the 100 acre **Applewood Farm** is a visitor friendly working farm. Pet live reindeer, take a pony ride, learn about potbellied pigs and pygmy goats, or take a hay wagon tour of a pumpkin field, Applewood offers an experience for every season.

Pick your own pumpkin, fruit or flowers at **Harman's Farm Market** in Churchville and take home a farm fresh treat.

Travel through Susquehanna State Park to step back in time at the **Steppingstone Museum** in Havre de Grace which preserves and demonstrates the rural arts and crafts of the 1880-1920 period. Students will learn about churning butter, laundry washing, day-to-day chores and see how farm life used to live before modern conveniences. Enjoy a picnic lunch on the hillside of Steppingstone.

Not far away visit **Keyes Creamery** where homemade cheese and ice cream is made to learn the process and sample the goods.

Adjacent to Keyes is **Mount Felix Winery** introduces students to the winemaking process from grape growing to bottling to branding.

Experience **Broom's Bloom Dairy** and Maryland's only robotic milking machine then end your day with their delicious ice cream.
